GRAPE VARIETIES:

60% Malbec, 25% Cabernet Franc, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot

GRADE:

14% vol

TYPE OF SOIL:

Very rocky and permeable

COLOUR:

Opaque purple-red colour

AROMA:

Smoky and saturated with black fruit, cassis and dark cherries

PALATE:

Opulent flavours of blueberry and blackberry are complemented by notes of roasted coffee and cinnamon on a long and lavish finish

KNOW THIS WINE BETTER

Belhara Estate grapes were hand harvested from selected old vine blocks. Alcoholic fermentation and extended maceration on skins took place for 30 days in open-top barrels with manual punch downs for better extraction and a lush and broad mouthfeel. The wine was then aged in 100% new French oak barrels (Mercurey Tonnellerie) for 18 months with gentle racking.
