GRAPE VARIETIES:

95% Tempranillo, 3% Cabernet Sauvignon and 2% Merlot

GRADE:

13% vol

TYPE OF SOIL:

Average Altitude: 813 m

COLOUR:

Purple red with a bluish rim

AROMA:

Fresh notes of red and dark berries, like blackberries and cherries, and balsamic notes of vanilla

PALATE:

Balanced, with soft, pleasant tannins. A round, greasy wine. Interesting ensemble of spicy notes with a forest berry aftertaste
